INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING DOGS

TURN TO THE CLASSIFICATION and select the class or classes for which your dog is eligible, then fill in the entry blank completely. **PLEASE PRINT OR TYPEWRITE** on entry form. Club and/or Show Secretary and assumes no liability for illegible entries. **In order for an entry to be complete the back of the form *MUST* be included with the entry.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTION OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES: The specific changes listed in Chapter 11, Section 6 (i.e. sex of dog, transfers between age specific regular classes and "move-ups" to BOV or BOB) of the Dog Show Rules are the only changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make *after closing of entries*.

THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY. Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Rules Applying to Dog Shows - Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. NO dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SHOW RULES

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES is 6:00 pm (P.D.T.), Wednesday, October 6, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or changed, "except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules".

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH ENTRY FEES TO: Roberta E. Martin, 870 Robinson Street, Oroville, CA 95965-4547. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the above address or by telephone at (530) 532-1338 romarot@gmail.com

POST DATED AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check **MUST BE MADE GOOD** by cash or money order **BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment will be required to pay a fine of \$25 per check and all items for which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or entries received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. An Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are **NOT** acceptable. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone, cannot be accepted.

TO BE ACCEPTABLE an entry must be submitted with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club entry form.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

SPECIAL DELIVERY & OVERNIGHT DELIVERY MAIL ADDRESS: Must be sent **no signature required** to Roberta E. Martin, 780 Robinson Street, Oroville, CA 95965

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. **AN ADMISINSTRATIVE FEE** will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$5.00 will be made.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

ALL DOGS SHALL BE kept on leash except when in the exercising, obedience, or rally ring.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and its Show Secretary will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. **DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

THE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over. The Show Secretary and Show giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the shows.

ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS DOG SHOW hereby waive any claim for damages against the club, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

Cleaning up after your dog is your responsibility!

Pooper-scoopers (in chlorine filled buckets) will be placed all around the show grounds and outside all show rings. If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or the rings, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for this show, you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing.

GROOMING AND SET-UPS - NO X-PENS PERMITTED IN ANY BUILDING

Dogs and Equipment may be left in these buildings overnight. But you do so entirely at your own risk. Please mark the top of each crate with the phone number where you may be reached should any problems arise in your absence.

All buildings will be locked from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. each evening. Neither the Officers & Directors, Employees & Members of the Alameda County Fairgrounds, superintendent or the Club assume any responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged property or dogs. Please stack crates and conserve space in consideration of others. A Roving Security Guard will be roaming the grounds overnight.

The Grooming Building is located just West of the Hall of Commerce and will open Friday morning at 6:00 a.m. and be available through the weekend.

DOG WASHING ON THE FAIRGROUNDS: The 1996 Clean Water Act is now being enforced at the Alameda County Fairgrounds. All gray water which includes soapy water from washing dogs) must be discharged into sanitary sewer systems only, and not dumped onto the ground or into storm drains. A hefty fine can be leveled against offenders. Del Valle will be placing Dog Bathtubs around the grounds for your convenience. Please look for designated dog washing locations.

Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

(The winners of these Classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed)

*Veteran Dogs

*Veteran Bitches

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

(The winners of these Classes will NOT be eligible to compete for Best of Breed)

* **Stud Dog Class**—For Stud with two Get and no more than four Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. The Get only will be judged based on their merits. Get must be entered and shown in a Regular or Non-Regular Class. Use the space for "Additional Entry".

* **Brood Bitch Class**— Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. *Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace—For two Rottweilers (a unit), irrespective of sex with at least one common owner and shown in the ring with no more than two handlers. Dogs may or may not be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class, but if not, must pay a separate Entry Fee. Use space for "Additional Entry".

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - JUDGE: Miss Danielle Warner

Novice Junior Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class—For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

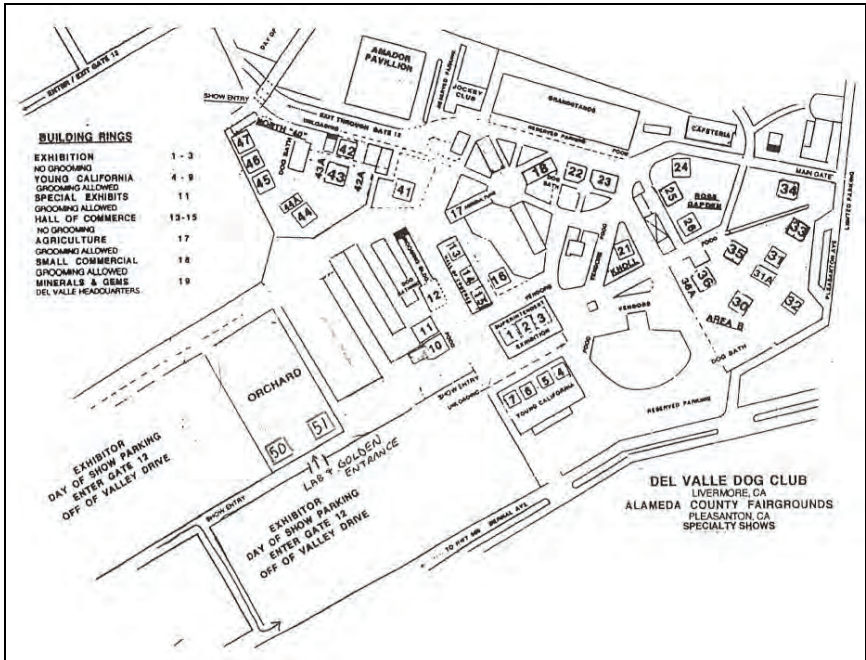

- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.*
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.*
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.*
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.*
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.*
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.*
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.*
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.*
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.*
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.*
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.*
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.*
